For those who have partnered with us over the years, you know that Rev. Vic Mangubat was my closest friend, and was my first spiritual son in the faith. Way back in 1980, just a few months after I arrived in the Philippines for the first time, Pastor Vic was hooked up with me by the Holy Spirit, and a short time after that, he resigned his full-time teaching job, and went to work with me and for me in this ministry. His wife, Mely, also resigned a short time after Vic, and side by side this couple stood with me, and then later, stood with Ethel and I, to work and see the vision of MKMI come to pass in the Philippines.

Pastor Vic went home to be with Jesus on June 28th, after battling with various illnesses and health issues for several years. One evening he went to sleep, and then never woke up for breakfast. His transition was smooth, and for that we thank this trusted and faithful friend. Pastor Vic went with me all over the country for all these years since 1980, and only in the last year or two was he not able to continue traveling with me due to his health issues. He was my primary interpreter for hundreds of crusades, seminars, church meetings, conferences and radio and TV tapings. He was also my National Director of Churches, helping me love and apostolically care for the hundreds of pastors we cover. Those of you who knew him knew him to be a jovial, lovable person who was always a joy to be around, and in many cases, the life of the party, so-to-speak. His laughter was infectious, and we will all miss him. But, in the eternal scope of things, we're happy he's in heaven with Jesus, now rooting us on from his vantage point up there. We pay special tribute to the man who, more than any other, was my spiritual son in the faith. He was not only my son, but my Timothy, and my close friend as well. I miss him, but look forward to seeing him again soon, when he comes back with Jesus to meet us all in the air (see 1 Thessalonians 4:17).

2008 MINISTRY TOUR NOW TAKING APPLICATIONS

The summer of 2008 isn't that far off! Next June 17-27, 2008, we'll conduct our 10th annual summer ministry tour, and that's only 9 months away! CONSTRUCTION GOES ON!

At I write this report to you, I'm pleased to inform you that we've now poured the 3rd floor slab for our 4-story dormitory, and completed the installation of all exterior hollow blocks for the 3rd floor of that building. We are now beginning to concentrate on the 4th and final floor, which is our roof deck. It will be about 75% covered when finished, and we're ready to move up and get that portion of the building finished in Jesus' Name. Since we began this construction project in 2004, we've been building this structure "section-by-section", with one section costing \$1,300." Please pray about helping us with one or more of these building sections, which will enable us to finish this structure for the work of our ministry. You can give the whole amount at once, or broken up in convenient installments that fit your budget. Whatever you do to help us finish this building, we thank you! Please designate your donations and contributions to this project when sending in your support, and follow the progress as we move up and onward towards completion in Jesus' Name. Our bible school is holding classes in this building now, it serves as the dorm for all our Bible school students, and is where our children meet for children's church on Sundays. Plus, whenever we do our major conferences and events, the dorm is where we host our visitors and delegates. It's a very important building to what we need and try to do for Jesus, so thanks for helping us by donating to finish building this structure – section-by-section!

In addition, we're now finished re-roofing our compound staff house, which is home to many of our ministry staff and their families. This building was built in 1989, and has never been repaired, renovated or refurbished in those 18 years. We have put a new roof on this building, and extended the roof line to cover more of the compound around that building. We'll be re-painting this building soon, as funds permit. New paint, new roof eaves, new windows, rooms re-designed and enlarged – many things. This is a project that is over 10 years late, but we're pleased to be in position to take care of these needed repairs, so we can keep providing living quarters for many of our staff and their families.

THIRD, YOU CAN HELP US BY BECOMING MEMBERS OF THE DOLLAR-A-DAY PROGRAM.

What is this? It's a support opportunity which asks contributors to set aside one dollar every day for MKMI support. Just one dollar a day! That's all. Can you spare that each day to help me win souls in the Philippines? You can give this monthly, by just adding up the number of days each month will have, or do it annually, semi-annually or quarterly. Doing this annually would be a gift of \$365. We have TV expenses each month, as well as regular crusades, traveling expenses to reach the more than 100 churches nationwide, church construction, and many other continuous activities which require income that the **DOLLAR-A-DAY** supporters could raise to help me. FOURTH, HELP ME FINISH THE THIRD AND FOURTH FLOORS OF OUR DORMITORY SECTION BY SECTION

Each "section" consists of 4 vertical support columns and 4 horizontal columns, along with the cement ceiling to top off the fourth floor roof deck. Basically, it's a cube, and each of these "sections" will cost us \$1,300 to complete. By building this 4-story structure section by section, we've been able to move from the ground up to the fourth floor, which is where we are as we move towards the end of 2007. Can you help me finish this dormitory by paying for one or more of these "sections". Your contributions can be made all at once, or broken up in whatever ways work best for you. One time total amount, or semi-annually. Or maybe quarterly, or monthly. Will you help me finish this building? Help us if you have the seed to sow!
