NATIONAL YOUTH CONFERENCE SUCCESSFULLY CONDUCTED

It was one of our most well-attended youth events ever, with more than 600 youth attending in our evening services, and over 400 delegates attending our morning and afternoon sessions. We thank you for your prayers and support, as this was a very anointed and successful event, with hundreds of youth being ministered to, challenged and encouraged in their walk with the Lord. This is the next generation of leaders and soul winners, so we're excited to have had this opportunity to sow into their lives with the Word of God, and the anointing of the Holy Spirit. FIELD MINISTRY RESULTS

Along with all the outreach, ministry and construction taking place in Ozamiz city inside and from our own compound and ministry headquarters, we are continuously ministering and reaching out to hundreds of pastors, leaders and church congregations nationwide. At present MKMI has about 100 churches that are under our apostolic covering, with more being added each year. Churches can be either affiliates or associates, depending upon the pastor's preference, but one way or the other, we count it a privilege to offer them apostolic covering, counsel and guidance. Each weekend, we have outreach teams who are sent out to visit and minister in our churches nationwide, wherever the Spirit leads us to go. Thousands of Christians are being ministered to in this way, and we expect this aspect of our ministry outreach to increase as we continue growing.

ANOTHER SUMMER MINISTRY TOUR REACHES THOUSANDS FOR JESUS

This past June 12-22, we conducted our annual summer Ministry Tour, which is an event where we invite Christians from the USA to come and work with us to minister the Word of God in daily crusades and outreaches. This year, 15 people came from all over the USA to participate in this June Ministry Tour, and for 7 days, we took three groups of missions-minded brethren out on crusade outreach. We went out twice a day, passing out handbills and knocking on doors in the morning, then coming back later

that same day to preach the Word, invite people to receive Jesus as savior, and pray for the sick.

Hundreds of people were ministered to during this year's tour, and hundreds accepted Jesus as Lord, with many healings and miracles to confirm the Word that our Tour group members delivered. This was our 9th annual summer Ministry Tour, and each year I'm blessed and encouraged as I watch God use our guests to deliver the Word and then confirm it through them with signs and

wonders following. This tour is open to anyone who loves God, loves missions, and wants to be involved with a fruitful, anointed outreach where hundreds or even thousands of people are reached in a matter of days! I hope you are one of those who will make the investment in time and finance to come and be a part of this great event held every June. Dates for next year's tour are June 17-27, 2008, and we hope you will be a part of the 2008 version of our summer missions tour.

TV MINISTRY IS BLESSING MANY

Another form of missionary outreach is our television ministry. We are currently broadcasting our program in three cities on the island of Mindanao, reaching thousands daily and weekly with our 30 minute show entitled The Sword of the Spirit Television Broadcast. The shows are produced in the USA, then the tapes are shipped overseas for broadcast. Please continue praying for this tremendous outreach. People are coming up to me frequently to let me know they watch the program, and get blessed with it's content. And our television personnel are also telling us that our show is their most popular broadcast; even more popular than some of the big ministries who broadcast via TBN or other Christian satellite networks. To God be the glory!

HEADQUARTERS CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

This summer has seen some tremendous progress being made on our various construction and renovation projects inside our headquarters compound in Ozamiz city, island of Mindanao. First of all, we're now working on the third floor of the dorm, pouring the columns and cross-beams in anticipation of laying the floor slab. Everything is moving along, and I'm pleased with the progress being made. Agree with us all that we'll be able to finish this building — all 4 floors, by the end of this year, 2007. I will be loading new construction photos by the end of summer, so you can see all the progress we've made over the past year, and even over just the past few months.

In addition, we're now busy renovating and repairing our compound staff house, which is home to many of our ministry staff and their families. This building was built in 1989, and has never been repaired, renovated or refurbished in those 18 years. We will be putting a new roof on this building, and giving it a total face lift externally. New paint, new roof eaves, new windows, rooms re-designed and enlarged — many things. This is a project that is over 10 years late, but we're pleased to be in position to take care of these needed repairs, so we can keep providing living quarters for many of our staff and their families.

THIRD, YOU CAN HELP US BY BECOMING MEMBERS OF THE DOLLAR-A-DAY PROGRAM.

What is this? It's a support opportunity which asks contributors to set aside one dollar every day for MKMI support. Just one dollar a day! That's all. Can you spare that each day to help me win souls in the Philippines? You can give this monthly, by just adding up the number of days each month will have, or do it annually, semi-annually or quarterly. Doing this annually would be a gift of \$365. Semi-annually would be \$182.50 twice a year. Quarterly would be \$91.25 four times a year. Monthly would be one dollar for every day of each month. For July, \$31. For August, \$31. We have TV expenses each month, as well as regular crusades, traveling expenses to reach the more than 100 churches nationwide, church construction, and many other continuous activities which require income that the **DOLLAR-A-DAY** supporters could raise to help me. If you're looking for good soil to sow your missions seeds into, please include us! Now more than ever, we need the generous support of missions-minded saints like you! You can designate any or all of your **DOLLAR-A-DAY** contributions towards our ministry in general, or one particular branch of outreach, such as TV, or crusades, or construction, or for any other outreach in particular.

FOURTH, YOU CAN HELP ME FINISH THE CONCRETE AND STEEL INSTALLATIONS ON OUR DORM'S THIRD FLOOR, AND THEREBY ENABLE US TO BEGIN WORK ON THE FOURTH AND FINAL FLOOR OF OUR DORMITORY SECTION BY SECTION.

Each "section" consists of 4 vertical support columns, 4 horizontal support columns, and a cement slab which will become the ceiling for the third floor, and the floor for the fourth floor. Each section will cost \$1,300. By doing this section by section, we've been able to complete the ground floor, and all the steel and most of the cement work on the second floor, and now we're working on the third floor, moving up and towards completion in Jesus' Name. Can you help me finish this dormitory by paying for one or more sections on the third and fourth floor? Your contributions can be made all at once, or broken up in whatever ways work best for you. One time total amount, or semi-annually. Or maybe quarterly, or monthly. Will you help me finish this building? Help us if you have the seed to sow! Many have given, and are giving into this opportunity, and we thank you for responding!
